Thank you for participating in Project See Me! We hope that this will be a healing experience for you and for others. In order for us to use your photo(s), you must submit this release form to us.

Irrevocability: This release cannot be withdrawn. Please be certain that you are able to share your photo before you submit it. After you give us permission to use the photo(s) you submit, we are not obligated to remove or return it. While we feel that it is our moral responsibility to care for you and to do our best to remove any photo later if it becomes necessary, please understand that we may not be able to do so.

Privacy policy: We will not share your name, e-mail address, or other personal information with outside sources. The picture you submit becomes our property and may be shared online, at professional conferences, in our video, in blogs, promotions, and for other professional purposes.

Age: We will accept photos from children, teens, and adults. However, if the kidnapping survivor pictured is under 18, this release must be signed and submitted by a parent or legal guardian. We may also contact the parent or guardian to confirm that adult's supervision.

Types of photos: Please see the instructions on our Website for guidelines and limitations. Photos should be digital and less than 3 Mb. Photos should be of kidnapping survivors only: Your photo(s) should be of you only. However, if there is some reason for you to appear with others, please tell us. Examples: You and your sibling(s) were abducted together when you were children, or you and one or more other journalists were kidnapped together while on assignment. If you have a circumstance that doesn't seem to fit the guidelines of this project, please contact us.

Legal limitations: We know how much this hurts, but we cannot use images of or information about perpetrators who have not yet been prosecuted.

Indemnity: This project is a service of the Tiffany Moon Foundation for Abduction Recovery. While we care for you and consider it our moral responsibility to do whatever we can for you, we cannot be held legally responsible for your mental health or safety. By participating in this project, you agree that you are 100% responsible for your own actions, health and safety, and you agree to indemnify and release from responsibility Tiffany Moon, the Tiffany Moon Foundation for Abduction Recovery, and its officers for any action or harm, physical, mental or emotional, real or imagined, that you may experience while participating in or as a result of participating in this project.
